Song Singing Project - Rang 2 & Rang 3

In recent months, our pupils in 2nd Class and 3rd Class have been engaged in an exciting project with Music Generation Laois. Alongside our regular tutor Nuala Kelly, MGL commissioned two composers, Lorna McLaughlin and Sarah Murphy, to create a suite of songs for and with children in 3 Laois Primary Schools. The childrens' voices and ideas were central to the development of these new songs.

This emphasis is on the developmental phase of the composition, so as to give the commissioned artists the time to authentically engage with children and develop their ideas and songs in a really collaborative way. Working with children, the composers have used musical games, percussion, singing and improvisation to explore themes relevant to the commission.

The composers have weaved together the children's ideas, themes, motifs and melodies and created a new suite of songs.

'Bicycles, Boomerangs and Blue Macaws' is the official title of the Children's Song Writing Project and we're excited to announce that the premiere performance will take place in **The Malthouse Stradbally on June 1st at 1pm**. Parents are welcome to the performance. We will have further details nearer the time.
