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
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## Internet Safety Talk for Parents

We recently introduced our 'Smartphone Charter' across the school. We are very pleased and encouraged by the uptake and response. When we surveyed parents at the time, a number of parents requested more support and information with regard to internet safety and how best you can protect your children and promote a positive online culture. Following on from this, and in an effort to embed our smartphone charter, we have booked internet safety talks for pupils in 3rd-6th Classes and an evening session for parents with Zeeko, a company who specialise in this area. The parents / guardians talk is booked for *Wednesday January 29th at 7:30pm* in the school. We highly recommend and encourage at least one parent from each family to attend.

## School Self-Evaluation

We are undertaking a self-evaluation of teaching and learning in Mathematics in our school. The views of parents / guardians are very important and can really help us. 
