Half-Day Closure March 28th

We remind you that the school will close at the earlier time of 12:30pm on Friday March 28th to facilitate staff in-service on the new Bí Cineálta procedures. Bí Cineálta is the new Department of Education led procedures that aim to support school communities to prevent and address bullying behaviour. Our new Bí Cineálta Policy, when completed, will replace our current Anti-Bullying Policy.

Spellings

As we soon commence a new cycle of School Self-Evaluation, we'd like to remind you of the focus of our current cycle that commenced 12 months ago. As a school, we evaluated how we teach spellings and we implemented a School Improvement Plan arising from this. In Rath N.S. we follow Brendan Culligan's Programme. Each child gets a list of spellings specific to their spelling needs. It is based on ability, not age or class. The programme promotes a visual approach and ensures children have a positive experience of spelling. There is no Friday test.

We encourage the children to:

- Use "Look, Cover, Say Write, Check" when learning spellings.
- We ask the children to examine the word in detail how many letters, long/tall letters? Doubles? Vowel patterns? Known strings? Words within words? Then picture these features
- Use mnemonics: Because-Big elephants can always understand small elephants
- Play games: Hangman, make word searches, make pairs games with flash cards of their learning words, play Tic Tac Toe with their words

Last year we shared a short document with parents/guardians outlining our approach to teaching spellings. The document also contains some useful information and guidance for you to help your child at home. For your reference, we have uploaded the document again to the school website.
